To have and to hold the same described property above bargained and sold to the said Thomas Trebble his executors, administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and behoof and I the said Robert Stapleton for myself my executors and administrators will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Thomas Trebble his executors, administrators and assigns the said described property against me my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons claiming the same or any part thereof.
