

Provided nevertheless that in case I the said Joshua Musgrove shall pay and satisfy to the said Doct: G Warfield his executors, administrators or assigns the sum of forty nine dollars Twenty five cents with Interest for the same on or before the first day of October next ensuing then this Bill of Sale and every thing therein expressed shall be void and of none effect, it being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said property is mortgaged by me to secure to the said Doct: G Warfield the payment of the money aforesaid. In witness whereof I the said Joshua Musgrove have hereunto set my hand & seal the Eleventh day of April Eighteen hundred and thirty.
