


and one plantation wagon, all of which property is now in my possession:

 persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
 Provided nevertheless that in case I the said Samuel Gartree shall pay and
 satisfy to the said Samuel Kissel or to his executors, administrators or assigns the
 sum of one hundred and twenty Dollars current money with Interest for the same
 at any time hereafter then this Bill of sale and every matter and thing in
 therein expressed shall be void and of none effect. It being the true intent
 and meaning thereof that the said above mentioned property is mortgaged by
 me the said Samuel Gartree to secure to the said Samuel Kissel the payment
 of the money aforesaid. In witness whereof I the said Samuel Gartree have
 hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this the seventeenth day of April 1830.

 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Jeremiah S Boyd do
 hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents
 do grant, bargain and sell unto the said James Williamson and James
 Iglehart their executors, administrators and assigns one negro woman named
 Denny aged about thirty years one negro girl Eliza aged about thirteen years
 and one negro boy named Robert aged about eleven years now in my possession.
 To have and To hold the said described property to the said James Williamson
 and James Iglehart their executors, administrators and assigns forever: and I
 the said Jeremiah S Boyd for myself my heirs executors and administrators
 the aforesaid property to the said James Williamson and James Iglehart
 their executors, administrators and assigns against me the said Jeremiah S
 Boyd
