Provided nevertheless that in case I the said Samuel Gott shall have defend and keep harmless the said Thomas J Hall his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns from loss or damage by reason of the suretyship as aforesaid by paying to the said James Boyle the amount of the aforesaid promissory notes, and all Interest which may accrue thereon by the time specified on the face of said notes, and shall pay and satisfy to the said Thomas J Hall or to his heirs executors administrators and assigns the aforesaid sum of fifty dollars and ninety eight cents with Interest thereon from the date of these presents, on demand in addition to the sum of one hundred and sixty two dollars and twenty cents with Interest as herein before stated and which last mentioned sum is contained in a mortgage bearing date the 31<sup>st</sup> January 1837 as aforesaid, then this Instrument of writing and every matter and thing therein contained shall be void and of none effect it being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said property is mortgaged by me the said Samuel Gott to save, defend and keep harmless the said Thomas J Hall by reason of the suretyship as aforesaid and to secure to the said Hall the payment of the money as aforesaid. In witness <sup>whereof</sup> I the said Saml Gott have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this sixth day of May eighteen hundred and thirty.
