


Brewer Junior his Executors, administrators or assigns the full sum of Two hundred and twenty dollars Current money with legal Interest for the same from the fifth day of April Eighteen hundred and thirty, or or before the fifth day of April Eighteen hundred and thirty one then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing herein contained shall cease determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes any thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.

In witness whereof the said John Carr hath hereunto subscribed his name and affixed his seal the day and year first herein before written.

Be it remembered that on this 17th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty personally appears John Carr party grantor mentioned in the within deed or Instrument of writing before me a Justice of the peace of the state of Maryland in and for Anne Arundel County and acknowledges the within deed or instrument of writing to be his act and deed and the chattels therein mentioned and thereby bargained and sold to be the right and estate of Nicholas Brewer Junior party grantee also therein mentioned his heirs and assigns forever under the conditions therein mentioned, according to the purport, true intent and meaning of the said deed or instrument of writing and the acts of assembly in such cases made and provided. This Indenture made this 18th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Samuel Gott of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland of the one part and John Wood of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas the said John Wood died at several times supersede three several judgements rendered by Thomas J Hall Esq. against the said Samuel Gott in favour of the persons herein after named, and of the following dates and amounts that is to say, a Judgement rendered by the said Tho^s J Hall on the 19th day of November 1827 against the said Samuel Gott in favour of Lewis Dutton for the use of John Trumble for the sum of Thirty five dollars and eighty nine cents current money debt with Interest from the date of the said judgement and fifty eight cents costs, which said judgement was superseded by the said John Wood on the 4th day of January Eighteen hundred & thirty - a judgement rendered by the said Thomas J Hall Esq. on the 27th day of February 1830 against the said Samuel Gott in favour of Elizabeth Allen for the use of Thomas Allen administrator of William Meens for the sum of Forty dollars with Interest from the 15th day of January 1827 current money debt and fifty eight cents costs, which said judgement was superseded by the said John Wood on the 39th day of April 1830 - a judgement
