

rendered by the said Thomas I Hall Esq^r on the 27th day of February 1830 against
 the said Samuel Gott in favour of Elizabeth Allen for the use of Thomas Allen
 administrator of William Weems for the sum of seven dollars and seventy three cents
 with Interest from the 23rd day of June 1828 Current money debt and fifty eight
 Cents Costs, which said Judgment was superseded by the said John Wood on
 the 29th day of April 1830, and whereas the said Samuel Gott to secure the
 said John Wood against any loss he the said John Wood might sustain in case
 of his having to pay the aforementioned Judgments or any part of them, he the said
 Samuel Gott is willing to execute these presents. Now this Indenture witnesseth
 that the said Samuel Gott for and in consideration of these presents and for and
 consideration of the sum of five dollars Current money to him in hand paid by the
 said John Wood the receipt whereof the said Samuel Gott doth hereby acknowledge
 and therefrom doth discharge and forever exonerate the said John Wood his heirs
 Executors and administrators and every of them, hath granted, bargained and sold
 and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said John Wood his
 heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, all and singular the stock herein after
 particularly mentioned and expressed that is to say, one Roan Colt three years
 old, one Bay Colt three years old and one pair of young Cows three years old.
 To have and To hold all and singular the said horses and Cows herein before
 granted, bargained and sold or mentioned or intended to be unto the said John
 Wood his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, to the only proper use and
 behoof of the said John Wood his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns forever
 Provided always and these presents are upon this condition that if the said Samuel
 Gott his Executors or administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be
 paid and satisfied the amount of the several Judgments which the said John
 Wood did supersede, that is to say, to pay or cause to be paid to Lewis Sutton for
 the use of John Trumble on or before the 4th day of January 1831 the sum of thirty
 five dollars and eighty nine Cents with Interest from the 19th day of November
 1829 Current money debt and fifty eight Cents Costs. To pay or cause to be paid
 to Elizabeth Allen for the use of Thomas Allen administrator of William
 Weems on or before the 29th day of April 1831 the sum of forty dollars with
 Interest thereon from the 15th day of January 1827 Current money debt and fifty
 eight Cents Costs. To pay or cause to be paid to Elizabeth Allen for the use of
 Thomas Allen administrator of William Weems on or before the 29th day of October
 1830 the sum of seven dollars and seventy three Cents with Interest from the 23rd
 day of June 1828 debt and fifty eight Cents Costs, and provided the said Samuel
 Gott shall and do well and truly pay in addition to the aforesaid Judgments all
 Costs that may accrue in any manner or in any way whatever on the aforementioned
 expressed Judgments, and the said John Wood from damages Costs and Charges,
 save harmless, then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing
 herein contained shall cease, determine and be utterly void, to all intents and
 purposes
