


Know all men by these presents, that I Caleb Davis - anne anndel County and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars current money of Maryland in hand paid by Jeremiah Tittle of Baltimore City, in the State aforesaid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged: have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Jeremiah Tittle his executors, administrators and assigns, one mulatto woman named Maria, aged about twenty five years, one negro girl named Charlotte, aged about ten years, one negro girl named Kitty about four years of age, slaves for life, one negro named Eliza, about eight years to serve; one negro girl named Catharine, about ten years old, to serve till thirty years of age, one negro girl named Fanny aged about six years, to serve till she arrives to the age of thirty, one negro boy named Dick, aged about one year to serve till thirty years of age, all my crop of Grain, and farming utensils and stocks of every kind & description now on the farm where I now reside & which may from time to time be made thereon, until the above sum of Five hundred dollars shall be paid and satisfied To have and to hold all and singular slaves, crop of Grain, farming utensils & stocks above bargained and sold, or mentioned or intended so to be, to the said Jeremiah Tittle his executors, administrators and assigns forever: and I the said Caleb Davis for myself my heirs executors and administrators, all and singular the said slaves, crop of Grain, farming utensils & stocks unto the said Jeremiah Tittle his executors, administrators and assigns, against me the said Caleb Davis my executors and administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this second day of September eighteen hundred and twenty nine.
