Know all men by these presents that I Alexander Duval of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty dollars current money to me in hand paid by Priscilla Pindell of the County and State aforesaid at and before the making and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Priscilla Pindell her Executors, administrators and assigns, one negro woman named Dolly Twenty five years of age and now in my possession. To have and to hold the said negro Dolly above bargained and sold to the said Priscilla Pindell her Executors administrators and assigns forever; and I the said Alexander Duval for myself my heirs Executors and administrators the aforesaid negro to the said Priscilla Pindell her Executors administrators and assigns, against me the said Alexander Duval my Executors and administrators and against all and every person and persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. Provided nevertheless that in case I the said Alexander Duval shall pay and satisfy to the said Priscilla Pindell or to her Executors, administrators or assigns the aforesaid sum of one hundred and sixty dollars current money with Interest for the same on or before the twenty third day of June Eighteen hundred and thirty five then this Bill of Sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and of none effect it being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said negro Dolly is mortgaged by me the said Alexander Duval to secure to the said Priscilla Pindell the payment of the money aforesaid. In witness whereof I the said Alexander Duval have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the twenty third day of June Eighteen hundred and thirty.
