



Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Sedwick, of Anne Arundel
County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of (fourteen
dollars and ninety cents current money to me in hand paid by Ephraim
Marfield Sen^r of the County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and
delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted,
bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the
said Ephraim Marfield his executors, administrators and assigns two
milk cows one red and the other black and white, all which property is
now in my possession. To have and to hold the same described property above
bargained and sold to the said Ephraim Marfield Sen^r his executors administrators
and assigns forever to his and their only, property use and benefit; and I the
said Thomas Sedwick for myself my executors and administrators shall and
will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Ephraim Marfield
Sen^r his executors, administrators and assigns the said described property against
me my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or
persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof. In testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the thirtieth day of July
in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty.
