



County & State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred & fifty dollars current money to me in hand paid by Thomas Welsh of the County & State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Welsh his executors, administrators or assigns one Bay Horse ten years old, Two beds bedsteads & furniture one Bureau two Tables, eight chairs, Shovel & Tongs, one set of Tea ware and Iron Shovel & Tongs and all my kitchen furniture consisting of Pots, Tubs, Pans &c all which property is now in my possession; To have and To hold the said described property above bargained and sold to the said Tho^s Welsh his executors, administrators or assigns forever to his and their any proper use and benefit and I the said John Hunt for myself my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and defend forever by these presents to the said Welsh his executors, administrators and assigns the said described property against me my executors and administrators and against all and every other person whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the twenty fourth day of July 1830.

Ridgely of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland am held and firmly bound unto J M Kingrore in the sum of Sixty dollars lawful money to pay him the same as well as in consideration of the sum of one dollar cash in hand to me paid before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained & sold & by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto J M Kingrore his heirs and assigns all my crop now growing it being two fields of tobacco & 1 field Corn & Potatoes & all other growing crop three stacks Rye and all my house hold & kitchen furniture 1 Plow & Giers: To have & To hold the same unto the said J M Kingrore his heirs & assigns forever.
