

Know all men by these presents that I Alfred Purdy of A A County State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of eighty dollars current money to me in hand paid, by John S Polby of the county and State aforesaid, at or before the enclosing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Alfred Purdy do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said John S Polby his executors, administrators and assigns, all my house hold and kitchen furniture one Cow, three yearlings, one Horse, one Cault, my crop of Corn and fodder in the field, crop of Tobacco now growing in the field and also all that is cut and is now in the house and three Hogs, To have and to hold the said described property to the said John S Polby his executors, administrators and assigns forever and I the said Alfred Purdy for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators the aforesaid described property, to the said John S Polby his executors administrators and assigns, against me the said Alfred Purdy my executors and administrators and against all and every person and persons whomsoever shall and will demand and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof I the said Alfred Purdy have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 19<sup>th</sup> day of Sept 1829.
