


County and State aforesaid at or before the unsealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Larkin Hammond do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Doctor William Hammond his executors, administrators and assigns one negro woman named Lucy aged about fifty years and one bay mare both of which is now in my possession; To have and To hold the said negro woman Lucy and said bay mare to the said Doctor William Hammond his executors, administrators and assigns forever; and I the said Larkin Hammond for myself my heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid negro woman Lucy and bay mare to the said Doctor William Hammond his executors, administrators and assigns against me the said Larkin Hammond my executors, administrators and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof I the said Larkin Hammond have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this thirty first day of August in the year eighteen hundred and thirty.

Know all men by these presents that I Patriack Connerly of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear to my beloved daughter Margaret Ann Connerly and also for divers other good causes and consideration I the said Patriack Connerly hereunto moving have given, granted and confirmed and by these presents do give, grant and confirm unto the said Margaret Ann Connerly the following property to wit one Black Cow and calf, all of my Tools and Tool Chest and one large Cloth Chest and all of the materials therein contained: To have, hold and enjoy the above named property unto the said Margaret Ann Connerly her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Margaret Ann Connerly her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever; and I the said Patriack Connerly the said property above described to the said Margaret Ann Connerly her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns against me the said Patriack Connerly my heirs, executors, administrators and all and every person and persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
