

Know all men by these presents that I Enoch Shekell of Anne Arundel County
 in consideration that Francis Shekell of the same County in security or about to be security
 on a note of hand for the said Enoch Shekell given to R. Esq. Henry Hall for the
 sum of Seven hundred and seven dollars with interest thereon for the 15th day of
 April 1837. and also in consideration of the sum of one dollar some in hand paid by
 the said Francis Shekell the receipt whereof he has by acknowledged hath granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Francis
 Shekell one negro boy named Peter about twenty five years of age a slave for life
 two yoke of Oxen one or two bay horses one bay mare one bay foal & one
 Roan foal which negro and other personal property is now in my possession
 To have and to hold the said described property above bargained and sold
 to the said Francis Shekell his Executors administrators and assigns forever to his
 and their proper use and benefit and the said Enoch Shekell for myself my heirs
 Executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
 the aforesaid negro & other personal property to the said Francis Shekell his Executors
 administrators and assigns against all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming
 the same or any part thereof shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
 Provided nevertheless that in case the said Enoch Shekell shall pay and satisfy
 the note above mentioned with the legal interest thereon and shall well and truly
 indemnify and save harmless the said Francis Shekell as security on the above
 mentioned note then this instrument of writing to be null and void anything herein
 contained to the contrary thereof in any wise appertaining In Testimony whereof
 the said Enoch Shekell hath hereunto set his hand and seal this 15th day of January
 eighteen hundred and forty one.

 of sale or instrument of writing to be his act and deed for the purposes therein mentioned
 and described according to the true intent meaning thereof and the acts of assembly
 in such case made & provided
