 of his family for and during his natural life and after his death to be equally +
 divided among all his children except ourselves by our late mother whom may
 survive him but with no authority to said trustee to sell and dispose of any of the
 negroes herein before mentioned unless the proceeds of the sale of such negroes
 negroes be immediately invested again in personal or real property for the
 benefit of his family aforesaid to be managed in trust as aforesaid and we
 the said grantors for ourselves or heirs executors and administrators respectively
 all and singular the above mentioned negroes unto him the said Edward H.
 Stewart his executors administrators and assigns against us the said
 grantors our executors and administrators respectively and against all
 and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant
 and forever defend by these presents having delivered up possession of said
 negroes at the time of sealing and delivering hereof fullness whereof
 we have hereunto set our hands and seals respectively this fifteenth day of
 February eighteen hundred and forty one
