 to hold the same describe property above bargained and sold to the said
 William G. Mackall his Executors administrators and assigns to her only use and
 benefit and I the said John T. Watkins for myself my Executors and administrators
 shall and well warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said William G.
 Mackall his Executors administrators and assigns the said property against me
 my Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons
 (Whosoever)
