 according to the terms and provisions of said bond then and in such case
 these presents and every matter and thing therein contained shall cease
 determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes anything herein
 contained to the contrary thereof notwithstanding and the said Jacob Basford
 for himself his Executors and administrators all and singular the property goods
 furniture & by these presents bargained and sold and every part thereof unto
 the said Basil Shephard and Richard Swanwick their Executors administrators
 and assigns against him the said Jacob Basford his Executors and
 administrators and against all and every other person and persons whatsoever
 shall and will warrant and forever defend In Witness the said Jacob Basford
 hath hereunto set his hand and seal, this day and year first written
