 & grown upon the Farm which Denys L'Angeville Represented to have and held
 the said property so as aforesaid described to the said Richard Stalling his
 Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Thomas B. Crandall for
 myself my heirs Executors and administrators the aforesaid property as above to
 the said Richard Stalling his Executors and administrators and against all
 and every person and persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forgive
 refund by these presents Provided nevertheless that in case the said Thomas B.
 Crandall shall pay and satisfy to the said Richard Stalling or his Executors
 administrators or assigns the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars and seven tyne
 Cents current money with the interest due on the same over before the 20th day of July 1842
 next ensuing then his Bill of Sale and every Mallett and thing therein expressed shall
 be void and of no effect Abiding the true intent and meaning thereof that the said
 property is mortgaged by me to the said Richard Stalling for the payment
 of the money as aforesaid as a collateral security for the same Bill of Sale whereof
 the said Thomas B. Crandall has hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the
 ninth day of July 1841

 proviso contained therein according to the true intent and meaning thereof and
 the acts of assembly in such cases made and provided aforesaid high and lawful seal

 in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of sixteen hundred dollars
 before him paid by James Evans junior of the County in a State aforesaid at or
 before the sealing of these presents the receipt whereof the said Nicholas Evans
 do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these
 presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said James Evans but his
 Executors administrators and assigns 1 negro man aged about eighteen years one
 (woman)
