

Nicholas, Owens do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Saml Drury Senr his executors administrators and assigns 1 negro Sam aged about eighteen years boy John aged about seven years boy Leard aged about four years, boy Thomas aged about six months one woman named Betty aged about thirty eight and girl Labet aged about seven years and three yoke of oxen four Cows and eight head of horses and now in my possession to have and to hold the said Negro Sam Betty John Leard Thomas Labet and three yoke of oxen four Cows and eight head of horses to the said Saml Drury Senr his executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Nicholas Owens for myself my heirs executors and administrators the said Negroes Sam Betty John Leard Thomas and Labet and three yoke of oxen four Cows and eight head of horses to the said Samuel Drury Senr his executors administrators and assigns against me the said Nicholas Owens my executors administrators and against all and every person or persons, whomsoever shall and will forever defend by these presents Provided Nevertheless that in case the said Nicholas Owens shall pay and satisfy to the said Saml Drury Senr or to his executors administrators or assigns the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars current money with interest for the same or before the tenth day of August eighteen hundred and forty five then this Bill of sale and every matter anything therein expressed shall be void and of none effect it being the true intent and meaning thereof and the said Negroes Sam Betty John Leard Thomas and Labet and three of oxen, four Cows and eight head horses is mortgaged by me the said Nicholas Owens to secure to the said Saml Drury Senr the payment of the money aforesaid to wit the sum of the said Nicholas Owens have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the tenth day of August eighteen hundred and forty one
