the said Negroes unto the said John Miller his executors administrators and assigns  
against me the said Mary Hunter, my executors and administrators and against  
all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will be arrant and  
forever defend by these presents In Testimony Whereof the said Mary Hunter have  
hereunto set my hand and seal this day of October eight hundred and forty one
