 Boy Lloyd unto the said John D Merican his Executors administrators and assigns
 against me the said Rich Luthcum administrator aforesaid my Executors and
 administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and
 will warrant and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal the twenty fifth day of November Eighteen hundred and forty
 signed sealed and delivered

 following property to wit Thoda Keaynes Coloured woman her wife for fifty dollars
 Adaline Keaynes Coloured Girl his Daughter for fifty Dollars. Fanny Keaynes Coloured
 Child his Daughter for fifty Dollars. Which said property I will warrant and defend
 to the said Keaysd Keaynes his Executors and administrators and against every other
 person or persons whomsoever in witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and
 affixed my seal this first day of September Eighteen hundred and forty one
 signed sealed and Delivered in the
