Money) to me in hand paid by Thomas L. Pitcher of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have Granted bargained sold and
delivered and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and deliver unto the said
Thomas L. Pitcher my negro woman by the name of Harriet about twenty one years of age
and the two children born of her one by the name of Leams about five years of age and
the other by the name of Eliza about ten months all slaves for life which said negro I
will warrant and defend to the said Thomas L. Pitcher his Executors and administrators
Cred Assigns against me my Executors and administrators and against every other person
or persons. Whomsoever in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal
this seventeenth day of September 1841 Abner Luthcum (seal)

 $\frac{26}{100}$ Dollars. one note payable six months after date for two hundred & ten $\frac{29}{100}$
Dollars and one note payable eight months after date for two hundred & twelve $\frac{13}{100}$
Dollars and whereas the said James D^r Werns to secure the payment of said notes and
to secure the said Elizabeth Werns from Loss or damage on account of said endorsements
