I know all men by these presents that I Abner Linthicum of Anne Arundel County  
and State of Maryland for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars (and  
Money) to me in hand paid by Thomas le Pichor of Anne Arundel County and State aforesaid  
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and  
delivered unto these presents to grant bargain and sell and deliver unto the said  
Thomas le Pichor my negro woman by the name of Harnell about twenty one years of age  
and the two children born of her one by the name of James about five years of age and  
the other by the name of Eliza about ten months all slaves for life which said negro I  
will warrant and defend to the said Thomas le Pichor his executors and administrators  
and assigns against me my executors and administrators and against every other person  
or persons whomever in thatness whereof I have herunto set my name and affixed my seal  
this seventeenth day of September 1841 Abner Linthcum (seal)

At the foot of the foregoing was thus written to me

Anne Arundel County & State of Maryland to wit On the seventeenth day of  
September 1841 before me one of the Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid  
appears Abner Linthicum and acknowledges the foregoing writing to be his act  
and deed according to the true intent and meaning thereof an Act of Assembly  
in such cases made and provided <sup>17<sup>th</sup> Sept 1841</sup> Wm Shipley

This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of November in the year of our Lord  
Eighteen hundred Forty one between James D'Wims of Anne Arundel County and  
State of Maryland of the one part and Elizabeth Morris of the said County and State  
of the other part Whereas the said Elizabeth Morris did on the seventh day of  
November eighteen hundred and forty one endorse five several notes drawn on that  
day by the said James D'Wims one note payable thirty days after date for one  
hundred & two &  $\frac{1}{10}$  Dollars one note payable sixty days after date for one hundred  
& two Dollars &  $\frac{1}{10}$  one note payable four months after date for two hundred & four  
&  $\frac{2}{10}$  Dollars one note payable six months after date for two hundred & two &  $\frac{9}{10}$  Dollars  
and one note payable eight months after date for two hundred & twelve &  $\frac{13}{10}$   
Dollars and Whereas the said James D'Wims to secure the payment of said notes and  
to secure the said Elizabeth Morris from loss or damage on account of said endorsements  
is willing to execute these presents Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said James
