

Know all men by these that I Joshua Rawlings of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars current money to me wherof paid by John Sewell and James Rawlings of the County and State aforesaid at an before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Sewell and James Rawlings their executors, administrators and assigns two Mares, one horse four Crows, twelve head of hogs two large Cails one light Carriage one large Karrow three ploughs one lot of Collaps one negro woman called Emily five beds bedsteads and bedding, one dozen Cane bottom Chairs one dozen Common Chairs two mahogany tables one eight day clock three pair brass candlesticks, one fender, Shovel and tongs one Star Carpet one gilt frame looking glass one Nineplate stove, half dozen Silver table Spoons, one dozen Silver tea spoons all which property is now in my possession Richard and Richard the same described property above bargained and sold to the said John Sewell and James Rawlings their executors administrators and assigns forever to them and their only proper use and benefit And I the said Joshua Rawlings for myself my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents to the said John Sewell and James Rawlings their executors administrators and assigns the said described property against me my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whossoever claiming the same or any part thereof In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15th December 1821
