

Know all men by these that Joshua Rawlings of Anne Arundel County in a State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars current money some where paid by John Sewell and James Rawlings of the County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Sewell and James Rawlings their Executors administrators and assigns two Mares one horse four Cows twelve head of hogs two large Cattle one light Carriage one large narrow three ploughs one lot of Cabbage one Negro woman called Emily five beds best steers and bedding one dozen cane bottom Chairs one dozen Common Chairs two mahogany tables one eight day clock three pair brass candelous one fender Shovel and tongs one Hair Carpet one gilt frame looking glass one nine plate Store half dozen Silver table Spoons one dozen Silver teaspoons all which property is now in my possession To have and to hold the same described property above bargained and sold to the said John Sewell and James Rawlings their Executors administrators and assigns forever to them and their only proper use and benefit And I the said Joshua Rawlings for myself my Executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said John Sewell and James Rawlings their Executors administrators and assigns the said described property against me my Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whosoever claiming the same or any part thereof In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15<sup>th</sup> December 1821
