This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of December in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand eight hundred and forty one between William Dury of Henry of Anne Arundel  
 County of the one part and Enoch Shekells of the County of aforesaid and George W Lawrence  
 of Calvert County of the other part Whereas the said Enoch Shekells and George W Lawrence  
 have become security for the said William Dury of Henry on a single bill dated on the day  
 of these presents for three hundred dollars payable to Samuel T. Roney trustee for the sale  
 of the personal estate of Richard G. Hubton six months after date with interest from date  
 and for the purpose of securing and indemnifying the said Enoch Shekells and George W  
 Lawrence from all loss which they or either of them may sustain by their aforesaid  
 suretieship the said William Dury of Henry hath agreed to execute these presents And this  
 Indenture Witnesseth that the said William Dury of Henry for and in consideration  
 of the above recited premises and of the sum of five dollars current money to him in hand  
 paid by the said Enoch Shekells and George W Lawrence as or before the sealing and delivery  
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold  
 and conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Enoch  
 Shekells and George W Lawrence and the survivor of them and the executors and administrators  
 of such survivor, one negro woman named Minta Wallis aged about thirty six years and  
 (one)
