


One negro woman named Susan Butler aged about nine years which negroes are now remaining in the possession of the said William Drury of Henry To have and To hold the said negroes unto the said Jacob Shekells and George W Lawrence and the survivors of them and the executors and administrators of such survivor forever to their only proper use and behoof and to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever Provided always and it is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents and of the parties hereto that if the said William Drury of Henry his executors administrators or assigns do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said Somerville Purkay or his Successors or assigns the aforesaid sum of three hundred dollars with interest as aforesaid and thus save harmless and indemnify the said Jacob Shekells and George W Lawrence their executors and administrators from loss and injury then this Indenture and every matter and thing therein contained shall cease and be utterly void anything therein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding. Know all Men by these presents that Rachel Sewell of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars in strictly legal and current money to me in hand paid by Henry & Thomas Purdy of the County and State aforesaid at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said Rachel Sewell do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry & Thomas Purdy their executors administrators and assigns one Parcel more or less all my farming utensils and all my household Furniture now in my possession To have and To hold the said property to the said Henry and Thomas Purdy their executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Rachel Sewell for myself my heirs executors and administrators the above said property to the said Henry &
