

This Indenture made this eighteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two between Elghman Scibb of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland of the one part and William Taylor of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars current money of the United States to the said Elghman Scibb in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents by William Taylor of aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Elghman Scibb hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said William Taylor his executors administrators and assigns a molato woman named Kelly Young a Slave for life to have and to hold the said molato woman as above stated unto the said William Taylor his executors administrators and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Taylor his executors administrators and assigns Intercity Whence the said Elghman Scibb and the said William Taylor have here to set their hands and affix their seals the day and year first herein before written
