

This Indenture made this eighteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two between Elghman Seble of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland of the one part and William Taylor of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars current money of the United States to the said Elghman Seble in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents by William Taylor of aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Elghman Seble hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said William Taylor his Executors administrators and assigns a molatto woman named Kelly Young a Slave for life To have and to hold the said Molatto woman as above stated unto the said William Taylor his Executors administrators and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Taylor his Executors administrators and assigns In Witness whereof the said Elghman Seble and the said William Taylor have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first herein before written

Gault Stephen Gambell, John Sewell and John Rice of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Whereas the said Benjamin E. Gault and Stephen Gambell are sureties for said Passmore McCullough on three notes (in bearing) date the ninth day of January eighteen hundred and forty one for the sum of one hundred and thirty eight dollars and fifty cents current money payable to Broth & Hotchkiss or order ten months after date and bearing date the same day and year aforesaid for the sum of one hundred
