 money to me in hand paid by William Heaton and Thomas Heaton of the same County
 and State at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof
 I the said Mary Layman do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and
 by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said William Heaton and Thomas
 & Heaton their executors administrators and assigns one sonet mare of the value of
 ten dollars one Gray mare ten years old of the value of thirty five dollars two milch
 Cows one Spotted the other red and of the value of ten dollars each one Yoke of Young
 oxen three years old next Spring and of the value of twelve dollars Two Calves
 Yearlings of the value of two dollars each one and six shillings of the value of eighteen
 dollars two beds bedsteads and furniture of the value of fifty dollars Side board of the
 value of five dollars and one day clock, and Cupboard, and Cupboard furniture of the
 value of ten dollars together with all and Singular the household and kitchen
 furniture of every description that is now in the possession of the said Mary Layman
 and of the value of ten dollars over and above what is specifically named above and
 one plough of the value of two dollars all which property is now in the occupation of the
 said Mary Layman to have and to hold all and Singular the said property household
 goods furniture and other the premises above bargained and sold earnest
 mentioned and intended to be to the said William Heaton and Thomas Heaton
 their executors administrators and assigns forever and I the said Mary Layman
 for myself my heirs executors and administrators all and Singular the said goods
 household stuff and furniture unto the premises unto the said William and
 Thomas Heaton their executors administrators and assigns against me the said
 Mary Layman my executors and administrators assigns and against all and
 singular and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant
 and defend by these presents of all and Singular which said goods
 household stuff and furniture and other the premises I the said Mary Layman
 have put the said William Heaton & Thomas Heaton in full possession by delivering
 to them one Cow, and one tablespoon at the sealing and delivering of these presents in
 the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold or mentioned and intended
 to be so unto them the said William Heaton and Thomas Heaton as aforesaid In
 witness whereof I the said Mary Layman have hereunto set my hand and affixed
 my seal this ninth day of February A D^r Eighteen hundred and forty two
