State of Maryland Anne Arundel County Court Know all men by these presents  
that I Thomas Blerland of the State of Maryland and County aforesaid for and in  
consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars and Seventy five Cents Current Money to me in  
hand paid by John Urquhart of the same State and County as aforesaid at or before  
the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Tho Blerland  
do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant  
bargain and sell unto the said John Urquhart his Executors Administrators and assigns  
the following property to w<sup>t</sup> Two oxen, one of which is ten years old and the other ne<sup>r</sup> Four or  
five years old but they work together in a common yoke to share in labour together  
to have and to hold the said property so aforesaid described to the said John Urquhart  
his Executors Administrators and assigns forever and I the said Thomas B.  
Blerland from myself my heirs Executors Administrators the aforesaid yoke of oxen to the  
said John Urquhart his Executors Administrators and against all and every  
person and persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these  
presents provided nevertheless that in case I the said Thomas Blerland shall pay  
insufficient to the said John Urquhart his Executors Administrators or assigns the sum  
of Fifty Dollars and Seventy five Cents current Money with the interest due thereon  
due on the same over and before the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of February next ensuing then this bill of sale  
and every matter and thing therein expussed shall be void and of none effect It  
being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said property is mortgaged by me the  
said Tho Blerland to the said John Urquhart for the payment of the money  
aforesaid as a collateral security on the same In witness whereof I the said  
Thomas Blerland have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the eighth day of  
February 1842
