Sherriff of the City of Annapolis and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of eighty five dollars current money to me in hand paid by John Randall of the City an estate aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said John Randall a negro man named Jerry Ross which said negro was seized and taken into Execution by me as the Deputy Sherriff of Anne Arundel County as the property of a certain Gustavus K. Parker to satisfy a debt due by the said Gustavus K. Parker to a certain John Sands. Polk and which said negro was manumitted by a certain John Redgely then of the said City of Annapolis and now of the State of Ohio, by deed bearing date the sixth day of April 1836 to be found among the records of Anne Arundel County reference being thereunto had will more fully and at large appear in which said negro under said deed is to serve until the 14th day of May eighteen hundred and forty four
