 transfer and set over unto the said Samuel Dunnock his Executors administrators and
 assigns all that the said Schooner called The Sarah Ann Webster of Annapolis
 together with all ~~and~~ ~~Log~~ her masts Yards Sails Rigging Anchors Cables Boats
 Tackle Apparel and appurtenances as she is at this time and is more particularly described
 in a Certificate of Enrolment granted her at the port of Annapolis in the following
