Know all men by these presents that I William Adams of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for and in Consideration of the sum of Eighty five dollars current money to me in hand paid by George Hamilton of Howard Street of Anne Arundel County in the said State at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt Whereof I the said W^m Adams do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said George Hamilton his Executors administrators and assigns all the goods household stuffs implements and furniture herein after particularly mentioned that to wit one pair mare one sorrel horse two red and white Cows one black and white heifer one waggon and harness seven hogs one wooden block one mahogany bureau set and singular which said goods and chattels are now remaining standing and being in a certain messuage or tenement Situate in Anne Arundel County and now in the occupation of the said W^m Adams as the Case may be To have and to hold all and singular the said Goods household stuff and furniture and also the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to be, to the said George Hamilton his Executors administrators and assigns forever and I the said W^m Adams for myself my heirs Executors and administrators all and singular the said Goods household stuff and furniture and also the premises unto the said George Hamilton his Executors administrators and
