deliver unto the said Charles Smith his heirs and assigns my negro Girl Sinai  
Slave for life and aged about ten years which said negro Slave Sinai I will  
warrant and defend to the said Charles Smith his heirs Executors and  
administrators and assigns against me my heirs executors and administrators  
and against all and every other person or persons whosoever In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal on the fifteenth day of  
November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty and  
Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
