Know all Men by these presents, that Joseph Chaney of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars current money to me in hand paid by Doct<sup>r</sup> Stevens Gambell of the County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Stevens Gambell his executors administrators and assigns one negro child called Ann two horses three cows twenty head of hogs and my crop of tobacco in the house all which property is now in my possession to have and to hold the same described property above bargained and sold to the said Stevens Gambell his executors administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the said Joseph Chaney for myself my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Stevens Gambell his executors administrators and assigns the said described property against me my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the fourteenth day of April in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty two
