Know all Men by these presents that Joseph Tydings of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars current money of the United States to me in hand paid by George Washington Rawlings of the County State of aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said Joseph Tydings do hereby acknowledge have granted Bargained Sold & by these presents do grant Bargain Sell unto the said George Washington Rawlings his Executors administrators and assigns one Parcel more or less Milk Cow Brown hoop feather Beds and their furniture Seven Hogs and one third of the crop that is now or may be hereafter standing on the ground where Thos Cranell now resides known by the name of Woodward's Farm all of which property is now in my possession To have and To hold the said property to the said George Washington Rawlings his Executors administrators & assigns forever and I the said Joseph Tydings for myself my Executors and administrators theirs the of aforesaid described property to the said George W Rawlings his Executors administrators and assigns and me the said Joseph Tydings my Executors and administrators and against all
