This Indenture made the eighteenth day of June eighteen hundred and forty two
 between Thomas Houghton of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland of
 the one part and Charles Blagitt of the same county of the other part Whereas the said
 Thomas Houghton owes and stands indebted to the said Charles Blagitt in the
 sum of three thousand six hundred and twenty nine dollars and fifty Cents and to
 secure the payment thereof with interest from the fifteenth day of November in the year
 eighteen hundred and forty one is willing to execute these presents Now this Indenture
 Witnesseth that the said Thomas Houghton in consideration of the premises and
 of the sum of five dollars to him in hand paid at the execution of these presents has
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain and sell
 unto the said Charles Blagitt his Executors administrators and assigns the following
 personal property to wit one negro man named Ned all my farming utensils
 two pairs oxen four horses one Cow and yealng ten head of hogs twelve and furniture
 eight Chairs one desk two tables China ware and all other furniture of the said
 Thomas Houghton To have and to hold the same unto the said Thomas H
 Houghton his Executors administrators and assigns forever Provided however
 and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the
 said Thomas Houghton his Executors administrators sales pay or cause to be
 paid to the said Charles Blagitt his Executors administrators or assigns
 the said sum of money above mentioned in five equal annual instalments
 bearing interest from the fifteenth day of November last as aforesaid then this
 Indenture shall be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue
 In witness whereof the said Thomas Houghton has hereunto set his hand and
 seal the day and year first aforesaid
