An d State of Maryland for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and two dollars  
current money of the State of Maryland to me in hand paid by Edward C. Williams of  
the County and State aforesaid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof I the said Richard W. Keuntz do here by acknowledge have granted  
bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Edward  
Williams his executors administrators and assigns one White Mare premrose with  
Short tail and white Mare jild with short tail one Sorrel mare pleasure with Short tail  
one Sorrel Stallion Van Buren with Short tail one yoke of Steers one d<sup>r</sup> Red an d White  
Loured Cows. fourty eight head of sheep eleven head of hogs all of which property is  
now in my possession To have and to hold the same described property above  
Bargained and sold to the said Edward C. Williams his executors administrators  
and assigns against me the said Richard W. Keuntz my executors administrators and  
against all and every person and persons whosoever shall and will warrant and for ever  
defend by these presents PROVIDED nevertheless that in case the said Richard W.  
Keuntz shall pay and satisfy to the said Edward C. Williams or his executors  
administrators and assigns the sum of one hundred and two dollars current money with  
interest for the same over and before the second day July next ensuing from this Bill of sale  
and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and of no effect It being  
the true intent and meaning thereof that the said property is amalgamated by me the  
said Richard W. Keuntz to secure to the said Edward C. Williams the payment  
of the money aforesaid In witness whereof I the said R. W. Keuntz have hereunto  
set my hand and affixed my seal the second day of June 1842
