granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell  
unto the said W<sup>m</sup> N<sup>o</sup> Wood his Executors administrators and assigns all his crop  
of Tobacco now made not yet packed supposed to be from seven to eight thousand  
weight of crop and second to have and to hold the same described pro party  
above bargained and sold to the said William N<sup>o</sup> Wood his Executors  
administrators and assigns, for ever, to his and their only proper uses and  
benefit, and I the said William Drury of H<sup>o</sup> for myself my Executors and  
administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents  
to the said William N<sup>o</sup> Wood his Executors administrators and assigns the said  
described pro party against my Executors and administrators and against all  
and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part  
thereof In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed  
my Seal the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 1839.
