This Indenture made this the ninth day of August in the year Eighteen hundred and forty two between Hamilton Bove of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland of the one part and Elizabeth<sup>o</sup> Bove of the county and State of aforesaid of the other part Whereas the said Hamilton Bove owes and stands justly indebted to the said Elizabeth<sup>o</sup> Bove in the full and just sum of three hundred and fifty three dollars current money and to secure the payment thereof is willing to execute these presents Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Hamilton Bove for and in Consideration of the premises and for and in Consideration of the sum of five dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said Elizabeth<sup>o</sup> Bove at before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Hamilton Bove doth hereby acknowledge and promise every part and parcel thereof doth hereby acquit exonerate and discharge the said Elizabeth<sup>o</sup> Bove her heirs executors and administrators and every of them by these presents hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Elizabeth<sup>o</sup> Bove her heirs executors administrators and assigns one negro Man named George Johnson, of a black Colour twenty four years of age and about five feet seven inches high To have and to hold the said negro Man hereby granted bargained and sold or mentioned or intended to be unto the said Elizabeth<sup>o</sup> Bove her executors administrators and assigns for ever provided always and these presents are upon this condition that if the said Hamilton Bove his executors or administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said Elizabeth<sup>o</sup> Bove her executors administrators or assigns the full sum of three hundred and fifty three dollars current with legal interest for the same on or before the thirty first day of December in the year Eighteen hundred and forty two then and
