

Myself my heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid Tobacco left to the said Nicholas Cavers his executors administrators or assigns and against me the said William Dury my executors and administrators and against all and every person and persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents PROVIDED nevertheless that in case I the said William Dury of New shall pay and deliver to the said Nicholas Cavers or his executors administrators or assigns the sum of Four hundred & Thirty Six Dollars and Seventy five Cents current money with interest due on the same make for the 1st day of Oct 1843 next ensuing the present year then the bill of sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and of no effect It being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said property is mortgaged by me the said William Dury to the said Nicholas Cavers for the payment of the money aforesaid as a collateral security on the same to witness whereof I the said William Dury have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 18th day of September 1842.

Dury of Anne Arundel County in the said State at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Samuel Norman hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Henry C. Dury of 10^m his executors administrators and assigns all the crop of Indian corn now growing on my land one yoke of work about 4 years old and the crop of tobacco now growing on my land to have and to hold all and singular the said stock and produce and other things premises above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to go to the said Henry C. Dury of 10^m his executors administrators and assigns forever and I the said Samuel Norman for myself my heirs and administrators all and singular
