 his Executors administrators assigns and against the said William Drury my
 Executors and administrators and against all and every person and persons Whomsoever
 shall and will warrant And forever defend by these presents Provided nevertheless that in
 Case the said William Drury of New shall pay and satisfy to the said Nicholas Cincus or his
 executors administrators or assigns the sum of Four hundred & thirty Six Dollars and Seventy five
 Cents current Money with Interest due on the same on or before the 1st day of Oct. 1842 next
 ensuing the present year then this bill of sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall
 be void and of no effect It being the true Intent and meaning thereof that the said
 property is mortgaged by me the said William Drury to the said Nicholas Cincus for the
 payment of the money aforesaid as a collateral Security out the same In Witness Whereof
 I the said William Drury have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15th day of
 September 1842.

 receipt Whereof the said Samuel Norman hereby acknowledge have granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Henry C. Drury
 of W^m his executors administrators and assigns all the crop of Indian Corn now growing
 on my land one yoke of oak about 4 years old and the crop of tobacco now growing
 on my land to have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid and produce and other
 the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to be to the said
 Henry C. Drury of W^m his executors administrators and assigns forever and I the said
 Samuel Norman for myself my executors my heirs and administrators sell and bargain
