Know all men by these presents that I Fielder Clevins of Anne Arundel County  
Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars current  
money of the United States to me in hand paid by Dennis Clevins of the same place  
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do  
hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents  
do grant bargain and sell unto the said Dennis Clevins his Executors  
administrators and assigns my negro man named Bazil aged about twenty  
six years all my household furniture of every description eight head of cattle  
four horses and a flock head of Negro. To have and to hold the said negro man  
Bazil and other property above mentioned and bargained and sold or intended  
to be to the said Dennis Clevins his Executors administrators and assigns forever  
and I the said Fielder Clevins for myself my heirs Executors and administrators  
the said negro man Bazil as a slave and the said household furniture cattle horses  
and Negro unto the said Dennis Clevins his Executors administrators and assigns  
against me the said Fielder Clevins my Executors and administrators and  
against all and every other person or persons. Whosoever shall and will  
violate and forever defend by these presents In Witness Whereof I have  
here to set my hand and seal this day of October in the year of our Lord  
eighteen hundred & forty three.
