Thompson to have and hold the said described Sonel mare to the said Mariana Thompson her executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Henry Thompson for myself my heirs executors and administrators the said Sonel mare unto the said Mariana Thompson her executors administrators and assigns against me the said Henry Thompson my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the eighteenth day of October eighteen hundred and forty two
