Provided nevertheless that in case the said John Allen shall pay and satisfy to the said William G Deal his Executors administrators and assigns the sum of forty five dollars and twenty seven cents current money with interest due on the same on or before the 6th day of Oct 1842 next ensuing then this bill of sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and of no effect. It being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said property is mortgaged by me the said John Allen to the said Rev^d William G Deal for the payment of the money as aforesaid as a collateral security on the same in witness whereof the said John Allen have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the 16th day of October 1842

This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two between Richard R Goodwin of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland of the one part and William Goodman Junia William Brewer Sen George McNew and William McMer of the County and State aforesaid of the other part whereas the said Richard R Goodwin owes and stands justly indebted unto the said William Goodman Junia in the sum of three hundred and fifty five dollars by his note dated the seventeenth day of August in the year eighteen hundred and forty two and whereas the said William Brewer Sen & George McNew stand bound for the said Richard R Goodwin as his securities on his bond as Executor of Catharine Phelps dated the ninth day of April in the year eighteen hundred and thirty nine and whereas the said George McNew and William McMer stand bound for the Richard R Goodwin as his securities on his bond as guardian for Albert Adams and Susan Ellen Adams dated the first day of August in the year eighteen hundred and
