

in this Bill of sale to the said Charity C Gosnell her executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Dennis H Patton for myself my heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid property as already specified and named to the said Charity C Gosnell her executors administrators and assigns against me the said Dennis H Patton my executors and administrators and against all and every person and persons whomsoever shall and will be arrant and forever defend by these presents Provided nevertheless that in case the said Dennis H Patton shall pay and satisfy to the said Charity C Gosnell or her executors administrators and assigns the sum of one hundred and ninety three dollars with interest for the same for which sum the said Charity C Gosnell now holds my note bearing the same date with this bill of sale when said note is paid and settled then over before the 13<sup>th</sup> of October 1844 Then this bill of sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and of no effect it being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said property as named and specified in this bill of sale is mortgaged by me the said Dennis H Patton to secure the said Charity C Gosnell the payment of the money aforesaid. Know all Men by these presents that Benjamin C Gant of Anne Arundel County for the purpose of securing payment of the debts hereinafter mentioned and in Consideration of the sum of one dollar current money to me in hand paid by Thomas S Alexander of said County at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Alexander his executors administrators and assigns one negro man named Frederick one negro man named Jack one negro girl named Leah and one negro girl named Minty which slaves are now in my possession together with their increase to have and to hold the said negro slaves and their increase unto and to the use of the said Alexander his executors
