Goodwin and William McNear stand liable to certain John Gibson & Company of the City of Baltimore as endorser for the said George McNear or and drawn by the said George McNear how and undated by the said Richard R. Goodwin & William McNear It is therefore hereby declared to be the meaning of these presents and of the parties thereto that all the premises herein and hereby bargained and sold or intended to be bargained and sold to the said Richard R. Goodwin in manner aforesaid are to be held deemed and taken in trust and confidence to raise by a sale of the same or any part thereof such sum as the said Nicholas Brewster William Brewster Jr. Poet Dennis Claude William McNear Robert Melchop of Ben William O'Hara Washington G. Luck or a majority of them or the survivor or survivors of them shall think proper and in a long due time much money as will be sufficient therefor and the same money so raised to apply to the purpose of paying off satisfying and discharging all and singular the said debts together with all interest and cost that may accrue thereon and with respects to save harmless indemnify and reimburse the said Nicholas Brewster William Brewster Jr. Poet Dennis Claude William McNear Richard R. Goodwin Robert Melchop of Ben William O'Hara and Washington G.
