I now all men by these presents that I Joseph Chancy of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and twenty dollars current money to me in hand paid by Thomas Gambrell of the County and State aforesaid a sum before the receipt and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted conveyed and sold unto by these presents to do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Gambrell all of my crop of Tobacco (now in the house) and also part of a cow four thousand pounds, and all of my crop of corn and fodder all which property is now in my possession to have and to hold the same described property above conveyed and sold to the said Thomas Gambrell his Executors Administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the said Joseph Chancy for myself my Executors and Administrators shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Thomas Gambrell his Executors Administrators and assigns the said described property against me my Executors and Administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this third day of November 1842
