

Know all men by these presents that I Dennis H. Butler of Anne  
 Arundel County for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar current money  
 to me in hand paid by Richard H. Butler of the City of Baltimore and by force of the  
 sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 and to secure the payment of such sum and sum of money as I now owe or may  
 hereafter owe to the said Richard H. Butler and to Butler and Town merchants  
 in and by him granted bargained and sold and by these presents to grant  
 bargain and sell unto the said Richard H. Butler his executors administrators  
 and assigns all my Tobacco now hanging or being on the farm or plantation  
 whereon I now reside in Anne Arundel County to have and to hold the said  
 Tobacco unto and to the use of the said Richard H. Butler his executors administrators  
 and assigns provided however that if the said Dennis H. Butler my executors  
 or administrators at any time before the first day of July next ensuing the date of  
 these presents at the request of the said Richard H. Butler and the said Butler and  
 Town shall well and truly pay to the said Butler and to the said Butler and Town  
 all such sum of money that I may now owe or at any time before the said first  
 day of July next may owe to him and then respectively these presents and  
 every thing herein contained shall be null and void and it is hereby to be  
 understood that if the said Dennis H. Butler my executors or administrators are  
 and are forthwith with all convenient speed to pack and prepare for market  
 the said Tobacco and permit the same to be sold by the said Butler and Town by these  
 judiciously sold for and on account of the said Richard H. Butler by whom the  
 proceeds thereof are to be applied in such manner as he may judge best to the  
 payment of such sum and sum of money as at the time of sale I may owe to the said  
 Butler and to the said Butler and Town and the surplus thereof if any to be held  
 by him for my use and subject to my order In Witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal this 21<sup>st</sup> day of November in the year eighteen hundred  
 and forty two.
