I know all men by these presents that I James Linnor Junior of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for an amount or sum of five hundred dollars current money to and in hand paid by Joseph Hower of the said County and State at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof of the said James Linnor do acknowledge and myself to be therewith fully satisfied contented and paid have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Hower his Executors Administrators and assigns the following goods and personal property to wit as the mentioned that to wit four head of horses three yoke of oxen three cows twenty head of hogs three Cows four further beds bedsteads and bedding three or four tables, one or two chairs one by one of iron and one thousand pounds of Tobacco all of which said articles so described are aforesaid and in the possession of the said James Linnor to have and to hold the said goods and personal property so described as aforesaid unto the said Joseph Hower his Executors Administrators and assigns against the said James Linnor any Executors Administrators and assigns I the said James Linnor do warrant and forever defend by these presents. J<sup>o</sup> W<sup>o</sup> Hunter whereof I the said James Linnor Junior have hereto set my hand and seal the fourteenth day of April eight hundred and forty three
